Construction of a 20M³ Reinforced Concrete Reservoir and Associated Infrastructure at Braakfontein Reservoirs

Bids are hereby invited from contractors registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD) with CIDB grading of 7CE or higher class of construction works for the construction of a 20M³ Reinforced Concrete Reservoir and Associated Infrastructure at Braakfontein Reservoirs, Newcastle, Kwazulu-Natal. The work to be undertaken includes earthworks, fixing of approximately 500 tonnes of reinforcement steel, in-situ casting of approximately 2 500m³ of concrete and forming of construction joints for the new water-tight 20M³ reservoir and associated valve and flow meter chambers. Supply and installation of DN 600 to DN 700 Mild Steel interlinking pipelines. Refurbishment of existing pipe manifolds and valve chambers to connect the new reservoir to the existing reservoirs on site.

Bidders will be evaluated in terms of functionality as part of the minimum requirements before evaluated on price based on the following criteria: A bid that scores less than 90 points out of 100 in respect of functionality will be regarded as non-responsive. Thereafter the 80/20 Preference Points system will be applicable, with 80 points for price and 20 points for B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution. NB: Bidders are required to submit original tax clearance certificate/ Tax Compliance Status Pin or CSD number and valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or certified copies thereof together with their bids, to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims. Failure to submit the proof of B-BBEE Certificate will result to a disqualification.

Bid documents will be made available at the office of the SCM Unit of Amajuba District Municipality upon producing proof of payment of a non-refundable fee of R750.00 per document. Deposits must be made into the Amajuba District Municipality's bank account: **ABSA Bank Account № 4053472593** with the reference number obtained from Amajuba District Municipality's SCM Unit. Bidders will be required to produce proof of the deposit before they will be issued with a bid document. Cash payments will not be accepted at the Amajuba office.

Bidders who do not reserve documents before this date and time will not be allowed to collect documents at the Compulsory Clarification Meeting. Reserved documents must be collected before or on the date of the Compulsory Clarification Meeting, because no documents will be issued after the day of the meeting. No copies of bid documents, in whatever form, will be issued to bidders. Bidders who fail to attend the Compulsory Clarification Meeting and the Site Visit will be disqualified. Documents may be collected during working hours between 07h30 and 15h00 as of **16 September 2019 to 25 September 2019**.
