

### **Buffalo Flats Bulk Water and Reticulations: Construction of ±70Km of DN75 to DN315 HDPE Pipelines for the Hilltop Settlements Water Supply Scheme**

Bids are hereby invited from contractors registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD) with CIDB grading of 7CE or higher class of construction works for the Construction of ±70Km of DN75 to DN315 HDPE Pipelines for the Hilltop Settlements Water Supply Scheme. The work to be undertaken includes trenching, bedding and backfilling for ±70km of pipelines; construction of reinforced concrete chambers, complete with fittings and specials; supplying, laying, jointing, testing and disinfecting of all pipes, valves, fittings and specials which are to interconnect with existing pipe work on the site; and finishing off site works including stormwater drainage, earthworks and grassing (where required).

Bidders will be evaluated in terms of functionality as part of the minimum requirements before evaluated on price based on the following criteria: A bid that scores less than 70 points out of 100 in respect of functionality will be regarded as non-responsive. Thereafter the 90/10 Preference Points system will be applicable, with 90 points for price and 10 points for B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution. NB: Bidders are required to submit original tax clearance certificate/ Tax Compliance Status Pin or CSD number and valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or certified copies thereof together with their bids, to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims.

Bid documents will be made available at the office of the SCM Unit of Amajuba District Municipality upon producing proof of payment of a non-refundable fee of R750.00 per document. Deposits must be made into the Amajuba District Municipality bank account: **ABSA Bank Account N° 4053472593** with the reference number obtained from Amajuba District Municipality's SCM Unit. Bidders will be required to produce proof of the deposit before they will be issued with a bid document. Cash payments will not be accepted at the Amajuba office.

No copies of bid documents, in whatever form, will be re-issued to bidders. Bidders who fail to attend the Compulsory Clarification Meeting and the Site Visit will be disqualified.
