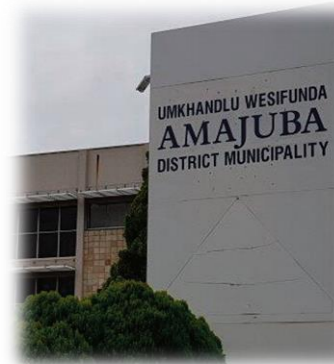

Amajuba will be a leading and a pioneering District Characterized by sustainable development and quality services.



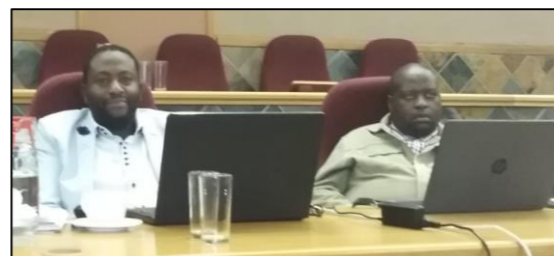
